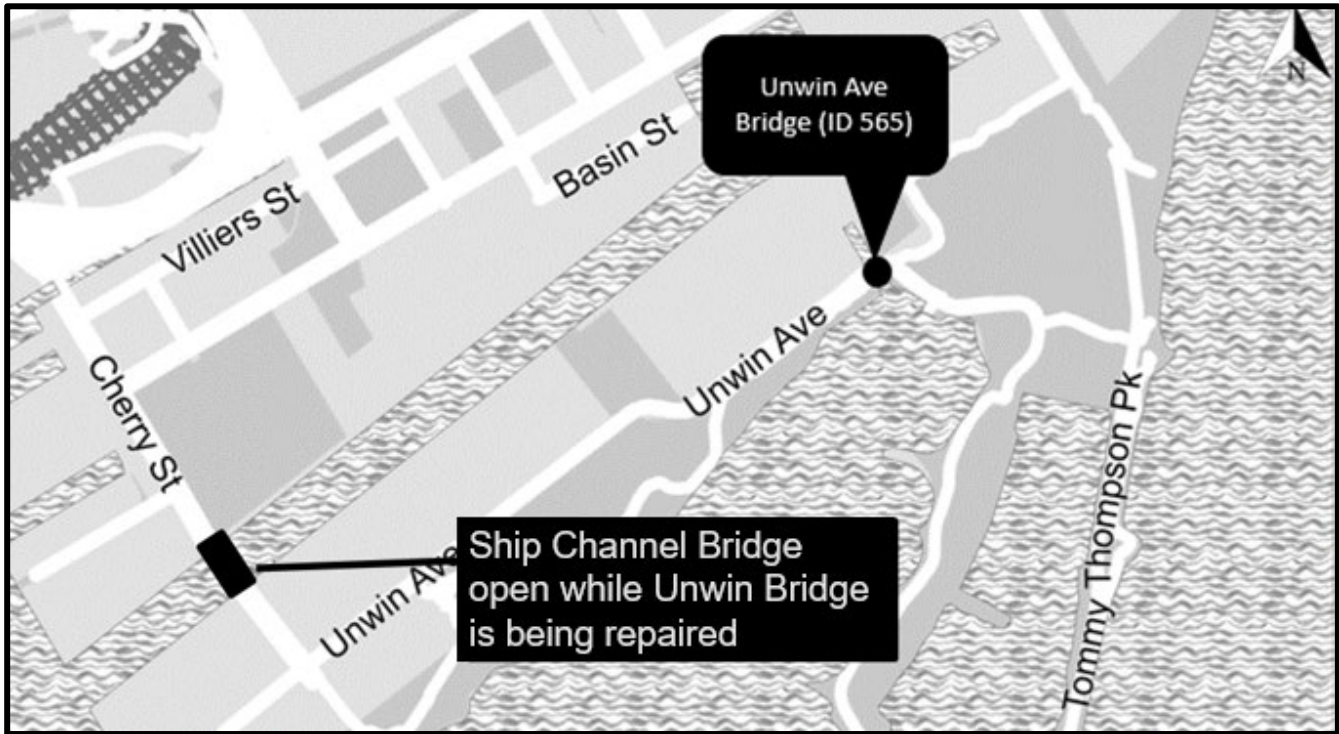
Unwin Avenue Vehicular Bridge Warranty Repairs

Contract: 24ECS-BE-14SB
Expected Work Date: September 13, 2026
**Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto will carry out warranty repairs at the Unwin Avenue Vehicular Bridge located between Leslie Street and Cherry Street. The work, originally scheduled for August 23, was postponed due to weather and has been rescheduled for **Sunday, September 13, 2026**.

During this work, the Unwin Avenue Vehicular Bridge will require a full closure for the day. The Ship Channel Bridge on Cherry Street will remain open for pedestrian and vehicle traffic. Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained via the Martin Goodman Trail bridge that is adjacent to the Unwin Avenue Vehicular Bridge. This warranty work stems from the original contract completed in July 2024.

WORK DETAILS

- Carry out repairs to the bridge deck waterproofing that is under the warranty of the recent contract completed in July 2024.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours and Contingency: Work is expected to take place for one day on Sunday, September 13, 2026, starting at 7 a.m. (work will continue until completed). If any portion of the work is not completed or cancelled due to weather or other complications, it will be rescheduled.
	Access: Motorized vehicles: Unwin Avenue Vehicular Bridge will be fully closed. The Ship Channel Bridge on Cherry Street will be open to traffic while the Unwin Bridge is undergoing repairs. Pedestrians and cyclists: The adjacent Martin Goodman Trail bridge will remain open for pedestrians and cyclists. Cyclists are asked to please be aware of construction traffic movements and obey signs and signals.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the **Project Manager** listed below.
