PHASED INTERSECTION CLOSURE Kipling Avenue and The Westway

Contract: 25ECS-LU-03FP
Start Date: early September 2026
End Date: late September 2026
*Content/dates subject to change

The City of Toronto is upgrading the storm and sanitary sewer system in your area to help reduce surface and basement flooding. This notice is to provide an overview of the planned construction disruption at the **intersection of Kipling Avenue and The Westway, with an expected duration of approximately four (4) weeks. This work requires road closures and will be completed in three phases.**

Residents can expect increased construction activity and traffic in the area during this time. The duration of each phase is approximate and may be extended as required to mitigate unexpected site conditions that arise. As traffic patterns and access may change throughout each phase of work, please follow the posted detour routes and traffic signage.

Please review posted signage to determine best routes for access in the area and plan for additional travel time.

The final phase of work will require a full closure of The Westway and Kipling Avenue. Additional details about the upcoming work and traffic impacts are provided below.

WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

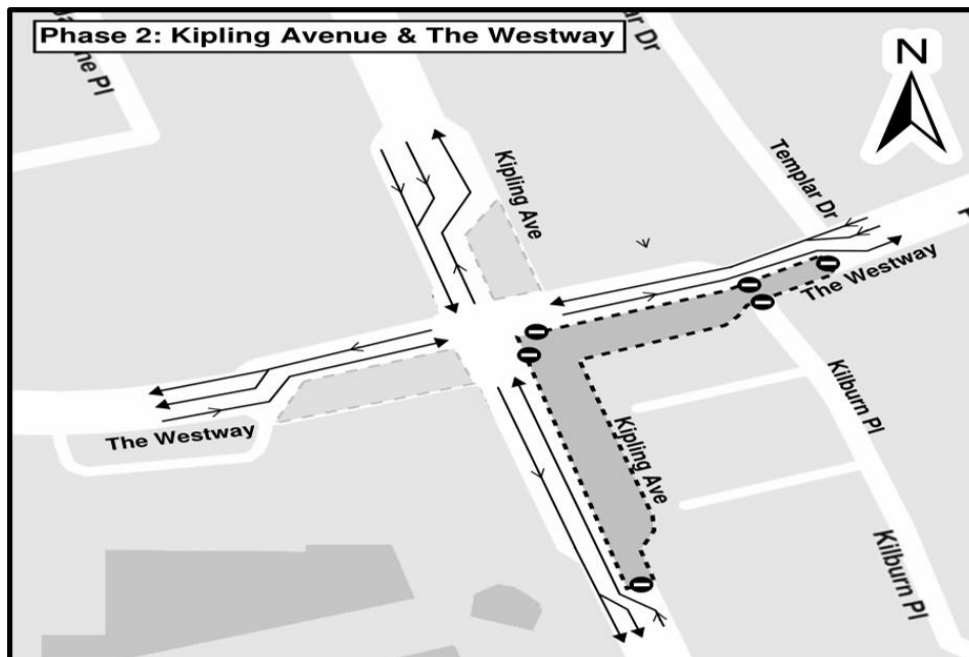
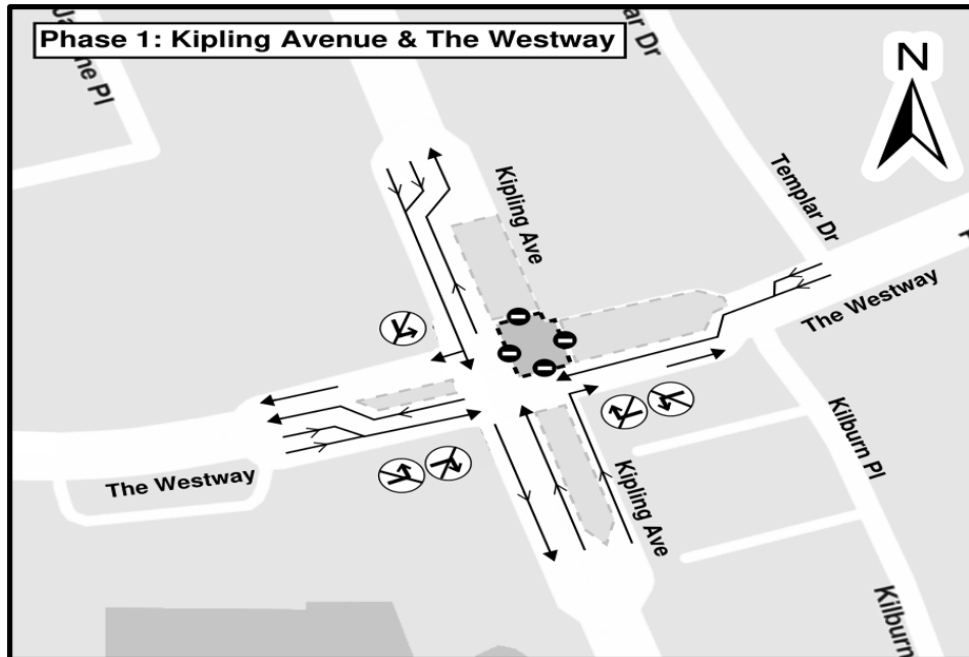
- Excavate at the intersection of Kipling Avenue and The Westway, to install the storm sewer and restore the area.

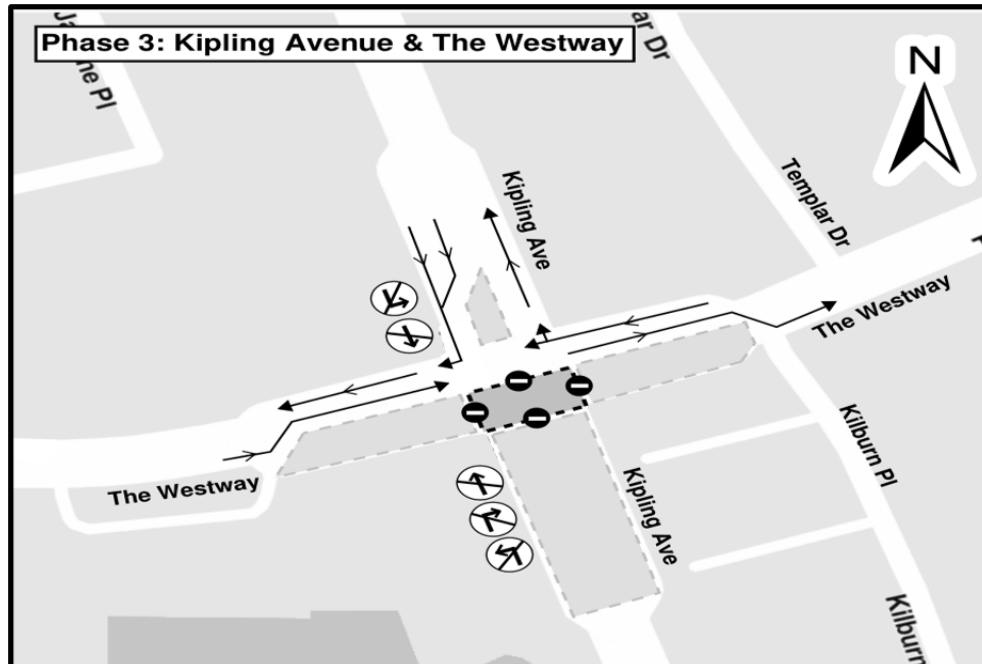
Phase 1: Anticipated to begin early September 2026. Work will occur in the north-east corner of the intersection. The timeline for this phase of work is estimated to take two weeks.

Phase 2: Anticipated to begin mid- September 2026. Work will occur in the south-east lanes of the intersection. The timeline for this phase of work is estimated to take two weeks.

Phase 3: Scheduled weekend closure at the end of September 2026. Work will occur in the southern portion of the intersection. The timeline for this phase of work is estimated to take three days of consecutive work. Overnight work will occur during this phase. **During this phase, Kipling Avenue and the Westway will be completely closed to southbound and northbound traffic.**

Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users, and residents.

Detour Route:

Phase 3: The southern portion of the intersection at Kipling Avenue and The Westway will be fully closed during this phase. Please use the detour in place: Eglinton Avenue travelling southbound, and Dixon Road travelling northbound.



Pedestrians: The work may require temporary sidewalk restrictions; however, any necessary sidewalk closures will alternate in each direction to ensure pedestrian access is maintained during construction.

In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

	Work Hours: • <u>Phase 1 and Phase 2:</u> Work will take place during the weekday from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. • <u>Phase 3:</u> Work will take place the last weekend of September 2026 (Friday to Monday). This date could change due to weather conditions.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, inform the contact listed below.
