

35 Bellevue Ave. Community Bulletin – September 18, 2026

Work in Progress and What to Expect Between September 18, and September 25.

Building Construction

Crews continue to install electrical, heating, ventilation, air conditioning systems, and drywall inside the building.

Roof and Siding Installation

Roof and siding installation will continue through September. This work will involve two cherry pickers on site to lift crews and materials.

Landscaping Work (September – October)

Backfilling

Starting the week of September 21st, previously excavated areas will be filled with soil and compacted to prepare the site for its final surfaces and landscaping.

Between 3 – 5 trucks per day, will deliver soil and stone to the site and traffic management personnel will help guide trucks in and out of site.

- Impacts: Expect moderate noise increased truck traffic, dust, and light vibration
- Measures: dust control, and traffic management in place.

Soil Compaction

In addition, starting the week of September 21st crews will begin backfilling around the foundation perimeter and in the courtyard using a handheld compaction machine as illustrated.

- Impacts: Expect light to moderate vibration



How Vibration is Measured

Construction vibration is measured in millimetres per second (mm/s) using Peak Particle Velocity (PPV).

Description	Approximate Range
Light vibration	Well below 5 mm/s
Moderate vibration	Up to about 5–10 mm/s
Heavy vibration	10 mm/s or more

Note: Heavy vibration is not expected during this stage of work.

Working Hours

Construction will continue to follow the City of Toronto's bylaw-approved hours:

- Monday to Friday: 7:00 am to 7:00 pm
- Saturday: 9:00 am to 7:00 pm
- No work on Sundays or statutory holidays.

The City recognizes that construction can be disruptive and has taken steps to minimize noise, dust, and vibration:

- Traffic safety personnel will help guide trucks safely in and out of the site
- Dust will be controlled using water and other approved methods including sidewalk sweeping.
- Vibration and noise will continue to be monitored to ensure work stays within acceptable limits
