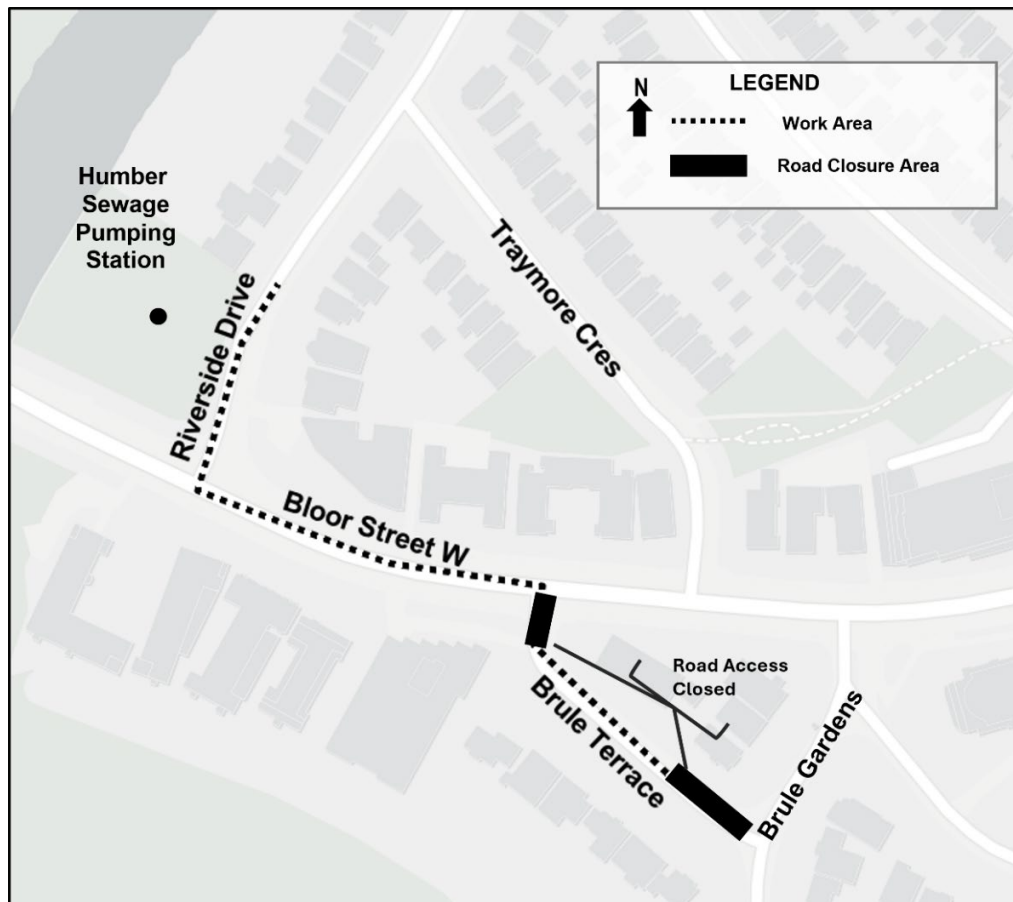

The City of Toronto will replace the sanitary forcemain in your area (a pressurized sewer pipe that transports wastewater from a lower to higher elevation) that has reached the end of its life cycle. This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure reducing the risk of forcemain breaks and collapses.

Due to the nature of this work, there will be **no access to Brule Terrace from Bloor Street West and from Brule Gardens** while construction takes place on Brule Terrace, from approximately September to November 2026. The road closures will last for two to three weeks, as required by the construction schedule, and **will not take place at the same time**. The timeline is subject to change.

Residents on Brule Terrace will have access from the available end of the street. Driveway access will be maintained. During construction, Brule Terrace will operate as a two-way street to accommodate the road access closures. Please find a map of the work area below.
