- A separate permission letter is required for each property owner if the project spans multiple addresses
- Permission letters are not required for gardens in City parks
- Replace all placeholders with the correct information before submitting

Special Cases

- School Projects: Letter must be signed by the school principal.
- City Boulevards: Letter must come from the adjacent property owner.
- City Parks: A letter is not required.
- Other City-Owned Land: Letter must come from City staff responsible for the site.

Save the completed letter and upload it with your application. Property owners may also send a letter by email to pollinateTO@toronto.ca using the same format. For emails, a signature is not required.
