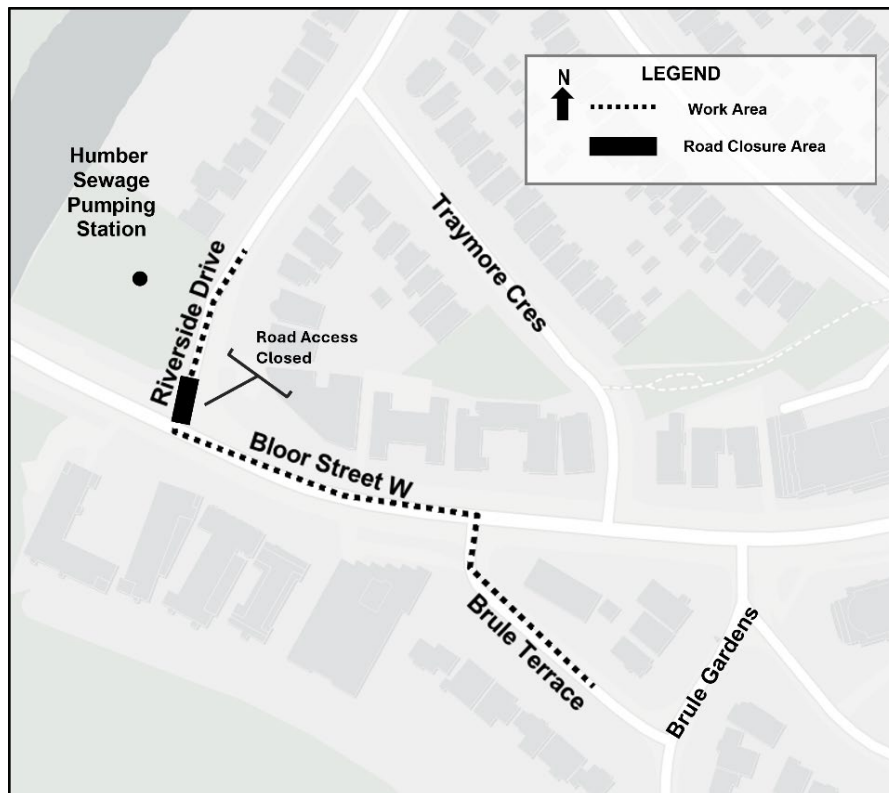

The City of Toronto will replace the sanitary forcemain in your area (a pressurized sewer pipe that transports wastewater from a lower to higher elevation) that has reached the end of its life cycle. This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Works Program to renew aging infrastructure reducing the risk of forcemain breaks and collapses.

Due to the nature of this work, there will be **no access to Riverside Drive from Bloor Street West** while construction takes place from the Sanitary Pumping Station to Bloor Street West, from approximately October to December 2026. The road closure will last for two to three weeks. This timeline is subject to change.

Residents on Riverside Drive from Bloor Street West to Traymore Crescent will have access via Traymore Crescent. Please find a map of the work area below.
