

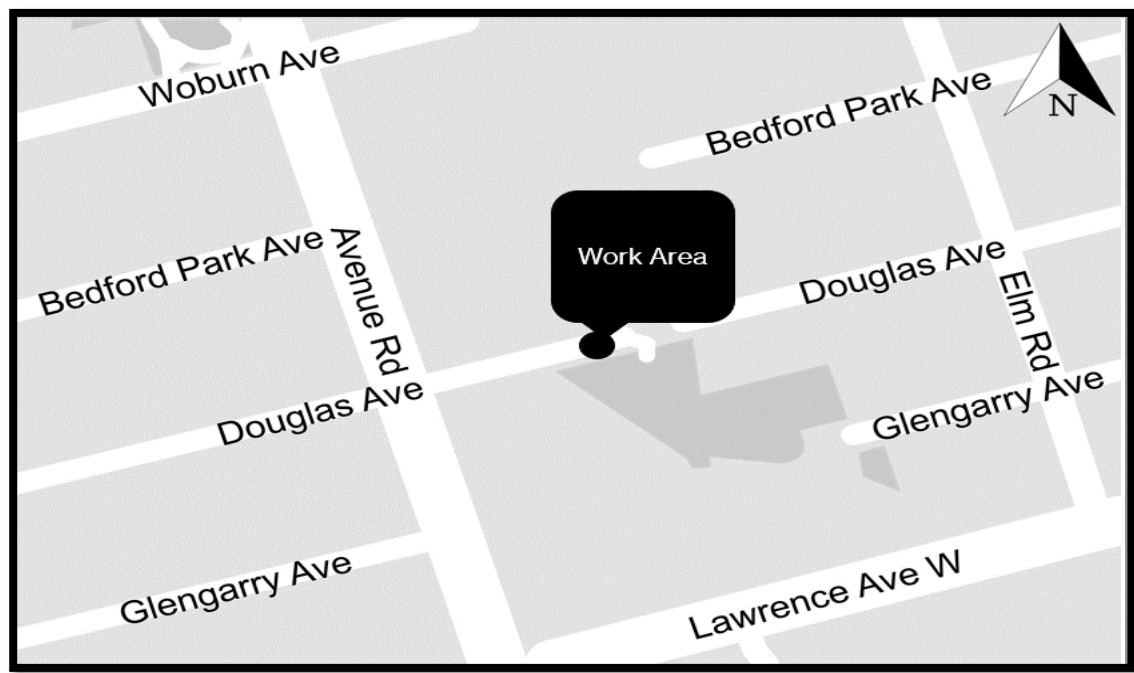

Douglas Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation over Bedford Creek

This notice provides an update on Douglas Avenue Bridge rehabilitation over Bedford Creek. Work on this project is currently behind schedule primarily due to encountering unforeseen site conditions and weather related delays. We recognize that this project affects all residents in the area. We empathize with you and appreciate your patience as we finish this work.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

- The City’s contractor has Removed deteriorated concrete on deck top, deck fascia and deck soffit;
- Replaced the existing parapet walls with steel railing;
- Patch repaired the concrete deck, soffit, approach slab, abutments, and wingwalls; Replaced the asphalt surface and waterproofing on the south side of the bridge;

REMAINING WORK

The City’s contractor will:

- Resurface or reconstruct the concrete sidewalks, parapet walls, and railings;
- Patch repair the concrete deck, soffit, approach slab, abutments, and wingwalls;
- Replace the asphalt surface and waterproofing on the north side of the bridge;

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce impacts. We appreciate your patience.

	Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Saturdays. No work will occur on Sundays and Statutory holidays.
	Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

	At least one sidewalk will remain open at all times. Temporary signage will direct pedestrians to safely cross the bridge.
	Traffic Management: Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. Spring -Fall (Super-structure works): All remaining work will take place on the bridge deck and structure. Traffic on Douglas Avenue will be reduced to a single bi-directional lane with temporary traffic signals. Access to Bedford Glen parking garage will additionally be maintained with a temporary traffic signal.
	On-Site Communication: There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility company branded clothing. If you need to speak with staff on the construction site, please ask for the Site Inspector
	Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, contact the Field Ambassador listed below.
	Restoration: The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed during ideal growing seasons only - in the spring (April to June) and fall (September to October).
