## **Basement Flooding Protection Program Fairbank-Silverthorn Storm Sewer System - Phase 2 Construction on Westmount Avenue and Genessee Avenue**

**Contract #: 23ECS-MI-03FS**

**Start Date: January 2026**

**NEW Expected End Date: June 2027\***

*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

**This notice is an update to the construction notice (and other updates) for the Westmount Avenue and Genessee Avenue area.** Please visit [Toronto.ca/fairbank](https://toronto.ca/fairbank) to view the previous notices.

The City of Toronto is advancing construction of a new storm sewer system that will collect, store, and move stormwater (rain and melted snow) from the Fairbank-Silverthorn area to Black Creek. This work is part of the City's Basement Flooding Protection Program to help reduce the risk of future basement flooding. Once complete, the new storm sewer system will help to reduce the impact of heavy rainfall and sewer back-ups for more than 4,600 homes in your area.

The City's contractor completed the microtunneling of new large diameter storm sewers on Westmount Avenue, Martin Street across Dufferin Street, and will continue microtunneling the sewers beyond. Once the microtunneling operation is completed and the equipment removed from site, the City's contractor will begin restoring the shaft compounds.

### **The following work phases remain:**

- **Phase 1:** Pre-work / Shaft Construction works have been **completed**.
- **Phase 2:** (Microtunneling): Continued until October 2026
  - Microtunneling west from Westmount Avenue, along Martin St., towards Dufferin Street and beyond.
- **Phase 3:** Maintenance Hole Installation and Restoration works (October 2026 to March 2027)
- **Phase 4:** Road resurfacing and paving (Spring 2027)
- **Phase 5:** Storm sewer on Genessee Avenue from Westmount Ave. to Glenholme Ave.
  - Once Westmount Ave. is fully reopened and restored, the City's Contractor will continue to construct the new storm sewers along Genessee Avenue using open cut construction method.
  - **A separate construction notice detailing this future storm sewer construction will be issued in the future, prior to the work.**

### **The following traffic restrictions will remain in place until the completion of Phase 3:**

- Vehicle traffic will be affected for the following streets:
  - Westmount Avenue between Martin Street and Genessee Avenue will be closed, inclusive of the two intersections.
  - Westmount Avenue, between Amherst Avenue and Martin Street, and between

Genessee Avenue and Rogers Road, will be temporarily converted from one-way to two-way traffic until construction is complete.

- Pedestrian access to properties will be maintained at all times.
- Driveways currently affected by construction will remain obstructed **until the completion of Phase 3**

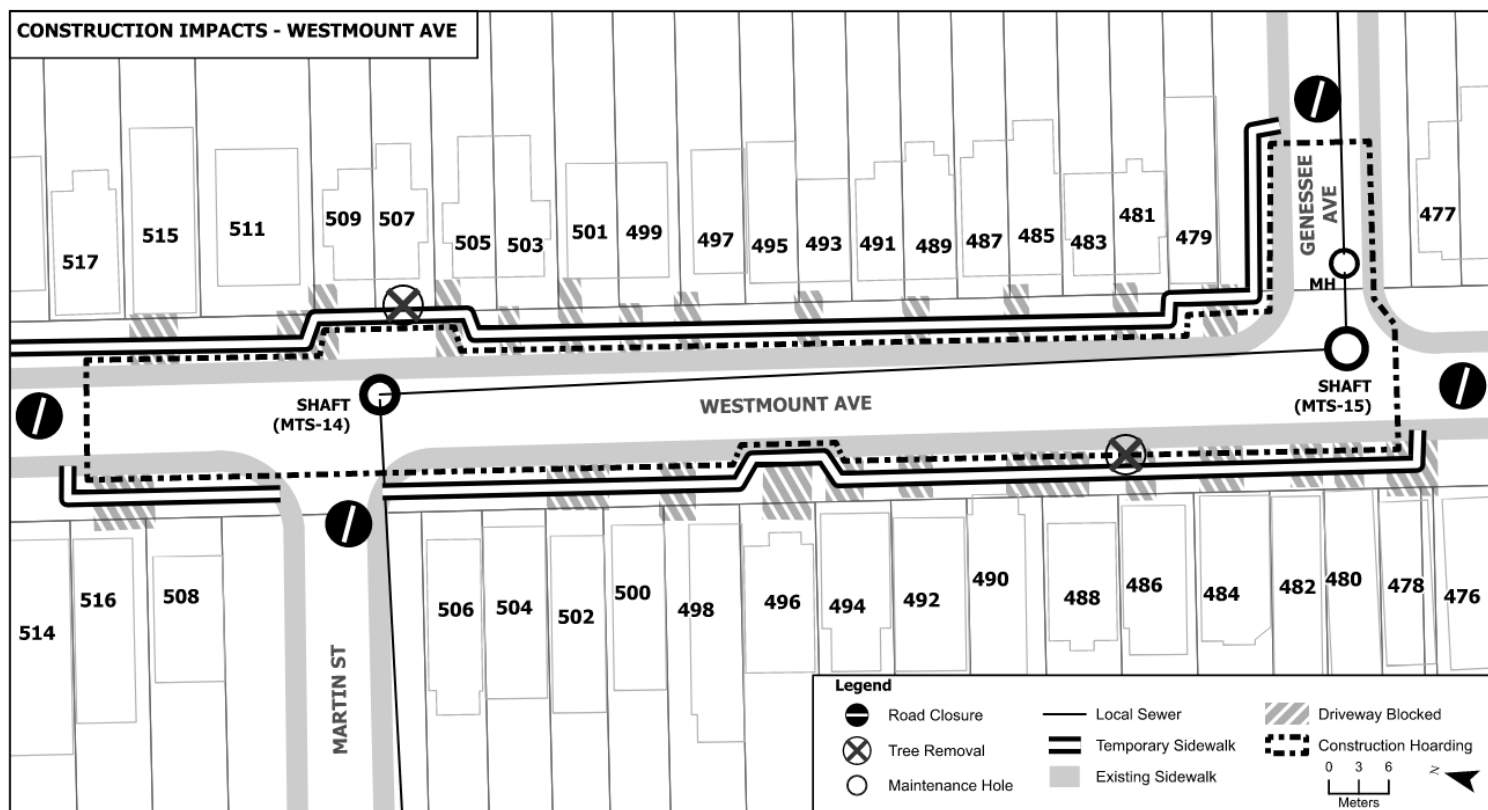
## WORK DETAILS

The contractor will:

- Continue to microtunnel large diameter sewers
- Install maintenance holes at the microtunnel shafts
- Resurface the road upon completion, and reopen the road closures
- Continue the storm sewer along Genessee Avenue (**A separate notice will be issued prior to this work**)

Genessee Avenue and Martin Street will be open to local traffic only.</p> <p>Vehicular parking on Westmount Avenue will be prohibited during the construction.</p> <p>Vehicles left unattended will be subject to “friendly towing.” Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Sidewalk Access:</b> Pedestrian access to properties will be maintained at all times.</p> <p><b>Driveway Access:</b> If your house number is mentioned in the list above, and you require a parking space for your vehicle(s), please kindly fill out the accompanying Parking Consideration Vehicle Intake Form along with Parking Permit Application Notice.</p> <p><b>Street Parking:</b> Street parking will not be available during construction.
